- If you cannot keep your appointment please contact us as soon as possible. Friendly cats – 48 hours / trapped cats by 4 p.m. the night before a clinic. Low cost spots are at a premium. Your “no show” means that someone else’s cat cannot be done.
- Kittens must be a minimum of 3 pounds to be neutered/spayed and receive a rabies vaccination.
- Cats should be in good health and should not eat after midnight the night prior to surgery. See page 2 for detailed surgery instructions.
- One Cat per secure, hard-sided, clean carrier please. The cat should be able to stand up and turn around in the carrier. We cannot accept multiple cats in one carrier for their own safety. **Please double-check that your carrier is securely locked!**

Animals considered eligible for surgery

Kittens weighing at least 3 pounds (surgery & rabies vaccination)

Animals NOT considered eligible for surgery

Any cat with: Nasal discharge – Seizures – Heart murmur – Poor body condition – Severe skin disease – Severe diarrhea or

Pre-Surgery Fasting Instructions

- Cats 5 months of age and older should have no food or water after midnight the night prior to surgery.
- Kittens 4 months of age and younger should eat a small meal and drink water at 5:30 a.m. the morning of surgery. Food and water should be pulled at 6 a.m.
- Trapped cats should receive food and water in the trap as per the above schedule. Trapped animals should be covered, and kept in a cool, dry, quiet location until delivered for surgery.

Cat Sterilization - \$45

Spay/Neuter, Rabies vaccination. May also include flea treatment, ear mite treatment, and ear tipping.

Additional Vaccinations / Services:

FVRCP \$10
(Recommended. Commonly called "distemper", vaccinates against Feline Rhinotracheitis-Calici-Panleukopenia. Should be boosted in 4 weeks)

FeLV Vaccine \$15
(Requires negative FeLV test. Should be boosted in 4 weeks)

Pregnancy Termination \$10

Cryptorchid Castration \$5

Tapeworm Treatment..... \$5

Microchip \$10

Antibiotic \$15

Ear Mite Treatment..... \$5
