INFORMATION PAGE – KEEP FOR YOUR RECORDS

Animals considered eligible for surgery

Kittens weighing at least 3 pounds (surgery & rabies vaccination)

Pregnant or in heat animals

Animals NOT considered eligible for surgery

Any cat with: Nasal discharge – Seizures – Heart murmur – Poor body condition – Severe skin disease – Severe diarrhea or vomiting – Severe flea infestation in kittens

Please make us aware of any concerns you have about your pet when you make your appointment.

PRE-SURGERY FASTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Cats 5 months of age and older should have no food after midnight the night prior to surgery. Water is okay.
- Kittens 4 months of age and younger should eat a teaspoon of food and drink water at 5:30 A.M. the morning of surgery. Food and water should be pulled at 6 A.M.
- Trapped cats should receive food and water in the trap as per the above schedule. Trapped cats should be covered, and kept in a temperate, dry, quiet location until delivered for surgery.

CANCELLATIONS: Call 724-503-8523. We request at least a 24-hour notice for all cancellations.

DROP OFF/PICK UP: Once you have received a scheduled appointment, drop off occurs between 6 and 6:45 A.M. Each cat should be in its own hard-sided clean carrier. Pick up is between 6 and 6:30 P.M. We are located at 18 West Pike Street, Canonsburg, PA. There is a metered parking lot directly across from our building.

AUTOMATICALLY TREATED SERVICES: Clients should be financially prepared for extra services that may be required. Prior to surgery a veterinarian will examine your cat and if needed, will treat automatically at the following cost: Pregnancy Termination (\$10), Cryptorchid Castration, Tapeworm Treatment (\$5), Ear Mite Treatment (\$5) and Antibiotic.

FIX 'UR CAT'S LOW-COST SHOTS & SNOTS WELLNESS CLINIC FOR CATS & KITTENS: Wellness Clinics are held weekly by appointment. General wellness concerns such as Upper Respiratory Infections (URI), vaccinations, ear mites, fleas, de-worming and nail clipping can be treated at our clinic. Wounds can be assessed and treated at our clinic (we do not have xray). Call 724-416-3265 for information or to schedule your appointment.

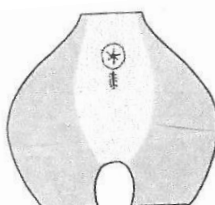

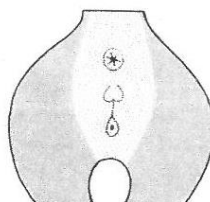
